## Baker New MHC Outreach & Development Coordinator

The MonDak Heritage Center in Sidney is very pleased to announce the addition of Jenny Baker, Outreach and Development Coordinator, to its staff. With a Fine Arts degree and minor in museum studies, Baker is extremely qualified to expand the Center's outreach programs in the community. Baker did her internship and worked at the Museum of the Rockies and also taught classes at Paris Gibson, the contemporary art museum in Great Falls. She has also been in and out of the school system, subbing, but also teaching classes, including art. She is married to Bryce and has two girls, a 1<sup>st</sup> grader and a 2 year old.

She is very excited about sharing her knowledge and love of museums and all they have to offer to everyone from infants to senior citizens. Baker is busy getting ready for MonDak Munchkins. Beginners, ages 1 and 2, will meet once a week on Mondays at 10 a.m. For these little tots, it will be an introduction to the museum, both history and art, in a fun and educational way. There will be lots of art projects, stories, and sensory projects such as quilt week where the children can touch and feel fabrics and ribbons.

Munchkins, ages 3 to 5, will meet twice a week on Wednesdays and Fridays at 10 a.m. This class will build on the basic Beginner principles, with more technique in the art projects, plus viewing the museum and learning more history.

The MonDak Masters for grades 3 through 5 will meet twice a week, Mondays and Wednesdays from 3:20 to 5 p.m. Because these children are a lot older and able to comprehend more, the program will involve a lot more technique, plus art viewing and history. There will be plenty of interaction as well with role playing in the classroom based on the downstairs displays. "There will be lots of options each week and lots of dynamics to everything," Baker enthused.

# Dr. LaPan Completes Training In Ankle Replacement

Dr. Michael LaPan, foot and ankle specialist, recently completed training in total ankle replacement with the InBone Total Ankle System through Wright Medical. Dr. LaPan is one of the first Doctors of Podiatric Medicine in Montana to receive the training with this innovative technology. The InBone Total Ankle System

has proven to be much better than its predecessors. Ankle replacement surgery has been around since the early 1970s, but the options were limited and the results were not ideal. Joint fusion has been the predominant surgical option for ankle pain, but patients often experience restricted mobility due to the fusion. The new InBone system replicates natural anatomy and allows the physician to adapt the ankle replacement

pieces to the patient's bone size and structure. This important feature allows for a more precise fit and less-invasive installation process with minimal bone removal and ultimately, better mobility. Dr. LaPan is a professional partner of Sidney Health Center and his practice is based out of his clinic office on the Sidney Health Center campus, Suite 103, with outreach clinics in Glendive, Williston and Trenton.

# World Aids Day

This year, an estimated 56,300 people will be infected with HIV in the United States. One in 5 of the more than one million people living with HIV is unaware of his or her infection. This year, in recognition of World AIDS Day, Richland County Health Department encourages all citizens of Richland County to get tested for HIV. The only way to know for sure if you have HIV is to get tested. You could have HIV and still feel healthy. Many doctors recommend HIV testing for all teens and adults between the ages of 13 and 64. It's especially important to get tested regularly if you are at high risk of infection. Get tested for HIV at least once a year if you:

- Have unprotected sex (sex without a condom) with someone who might have HIV.
- Have sex with men who have sex with men.
- Use drugs with needles.
- Have a sex partner who is HIV-positive.
- Have had a sexually transmitted disease (STD).

## USDA Board Approves Damage Assessment Reports

The U.S. Department of Agriculture's North Dakota State Emergency Board reviewed and approved damage assessment reports for 16 North Dakota counties recently. The reports will now be sent on to Secretary of Agriculture Tom Vilsack to support a potential disaster designation for those counties.

The damage assessment process was completed in response to Governor Jack Dalrymple's request to Secretary of Agriculture Tom Vilsack for a secretarial disaster designation. The designation, if made by the Secretary, makes low-interest emergency loans available to eligible producers.

"The sixteen counties we

looked at today are in addition to 25 counties already designated under USDA's fast-track designation process for drought," said Aaron Krauter, State Executive Director for Farm Service Agency in North Dakota and chair of the State Emergency Board. "These additional counties saw significant forage losses because of both dry conditions and insect damage."

# Fish House Regulations

Winter anglers are reminded that any fish house left unoccupied on North Dakota waters must be made out of materials that will allow it to float.

A popular question this time of the year is if campers qualify as legal fish houses. The answer is the same for any structure taken on the ice – if it's left unattended, it must be able to float; if it's not able to float, it must be removed when the angler leaves the ice.

Other fish house regulations include:  
Fish houses do not require a license.  
Occupied structures do not require identification. However, any unoccupied fish house must have the owner's name, and either address or telephone number, displayed on its outside in readily distinguishable characters at least three inches high.  
Fish houses may not be placed closer than 50 feet in any direction to another house without consent of the occupant of the other fish house.  
Fish houses shall be removed from all waters by midnight, March 15, of each year. They can be used after March 15 if they are removed daily.  
Anglers should refer to the 2012-14 North Dakota Fishing Guide for winter fishing regulations.

# FWP Commission to Meet in Helena December 20

Montana's Fish, Wildlife & Parks Commission will meet in Helena Dec. 20 to consider final approval of a statewide fisheries management plan and the City of Helena's plan to manage deer within the city limits.

The meeting, set to begin at 8:30 a.m., will be held at FWP's Helena headquarters, 1420 E. Sixth Ave.

Commissioners also will consider approving new rules for Montana State Parks fees and the Smith River. Final approval will also be sought on water rights on Nevada Spring Creek near Helmsville, 2013 fishing regulations for Red Rock Lakes National Wildlife Refuge east of Monida, a Spotted Dog Wildlife Management Area grazing lease near Deer Lodge, wildlife management area rules, and a bighorn sheep transplant to the Bridger Mountains near Bozeman.

The Statewide Fisheries Management Plan will help set future FWP fishing regulations, budget and project priorities, and routine management decision-making processes. The proposed final plan, decision notice, and public comments are available via FWP's website at [fwp.mt.gov](http://fwp.mt.gov). Click "Statewide Fisheries Management Plan".

Topics proposed for initial consideration include the management of the Madison Buffalo Jump State Park near Manhattan, the annual rule for fishing access sites, upcoming black bear and spring turkey hunting quotas, and the closure of bighorn sheep hunting district 455 north of Helena.

FWP will ask commissioners to endorse a cooperative sage grouse transplant project with North Dakota and offer an update on the Bitterroot Elk Project.

## Symposium for Montana/ Wyoming Barley and Sugarbeet Growers Set for Jan. 9 & 10

The 2013 Montana/ Wyoming Sugar Beet Symposium will be held in Billings at the Big Horn Resort on Wednesday and Thursday, January 9-10, 2013.

The symposium will feature top experts from Montana State University, University of Wyoming, North Dakota State University and Kansas State University, the federal Agricultural Research Service (from Sidney and Kimberly, Idaho stations), as well as from private industry. There will also be a trade show with exhibits by many agricultural input suppliers.

Wednesday's program will focus on malt barley production, irrigation, grain storage, and corn genetics for dry-land and irrigated grow-

ers, pulse crops and crop protection (including managing weed, disease and insect pests of corn, dry beans, and wheat grown in rotation with sugarbeets and barley).

There will be presentations by faculty from Montana State University, University of Wyoming, Pioneer Hi-Bred, North Dakota State University and Kansas State University. Meteorologist John Pulaski will present a 2013 weather outlook.

On Wednesday there will be a sponsored soup and sandwich lunch at noon.

On Thursday, following a 6:30 a.m. breakfast sponsored by the Billings Chamber of Commerce, presentations will focus on sugarbeet production, including fertility, irrigation, new genetics, new equipment, plus insect, weed

and disease management.

Ruthann Geib, vice president of the American Sugarbeet Growers Association will present a Washington update, as well as updates on the use of Roundup-ready sugarbeets and other issues affecting the future of the sugarbeet industry.

There will be a forum on control of rhizoctonia crown and root rot and a presenta-

tion by Carl Strausbaugh on effects of virus diseases on sugarbeet storage.

The full agenda and registration information are available at <http://ipm.montana.edu>. Pre-registration is \$20 per day. Registration at the door is \$25 per day. The 2013 symposium was developed by representatives from Sidney Sugars, Western Sugar, Wyoming Sugar, as well as MSU and others.

## Little Bit Country Wheat Quality Improves Over 2012

The North Dakota Wheat Commission recently released the 2012 Regional Quality Reports for both U.S. hard spring wheat and northern durum wheat. The hard red spring wheat samples were produced in North Dakota, Montana, Minnesota, South Dakota, Idaho and Oregon while the durum samples were taken from North Dakota and Montana.

The northern durum crop grades a number one Hard Amber Durum on average with slightly higher test weights and thousand kernel weights compared to last year. Vitreous kernel content is slightly higher this year at 89 percent. At 14.6 percent, average protein is one point higher than 2011 and half a point higher than average and falling numbers averaged above 400 seconds, indicating a sound crop. Total semolina extraction levels are a bit lower than last year but mixing properties are strong. Pasta quality is improved this year with lower speck counts, better pasta color and lower cooking loss. While the crop as a whole is of good quality, the northern region of North Dakota did see increased disease pressure with some elevated levels of DON. Also, this year there is a portion of the crop that falls into lower grade classes with lower vitreous counts. Overall, buyers will appreciate the high grading crop with improved semolina and processing characteristics, according to Jim Peterson, Marketing Director of the Wheat Commission.

Peterson also reports the 2012 Hard Red Spring grades a number one Dark Northern Spring with higher test weights and thousand kernel weights. Average protein is 14.6 percent, similar to last year and nearly a half point higher than the five-year average. Damage levels are significantly lower with only a few areas reporting elevated levels of DON. These areas include the

northwest and north central portions of North Dakota. Milling data shows extraction levels are higher than last year and similar to the five-year average. Dough quality tests indicate stronger, more resistant dough in the 2012 crop showing lower bake absorption but higher loaf volumes. The strong features of the 2012 hard red spring crop include very high protein levels, a high grade profile, low damage, improved functional quality and larger production.

The state offices of the National Agricultural Statistics Service collected the sample and the North Dakota State University wheat quality labs conducted the evaluations. A total of 786 hard spring wheat and 221 durum samples were collected and analyzed.

### Yield and Quality of Wheats Seem Incompatible

Last week I attended our district meeting of the North Dakota Crop Improvement Association. This is a statewide organization which works with North Dakota State University in the distribution of new crop varieties developed by NDSU breeders and sometimes from other states. Contract crop growers and seed dealers make up the membership. County Extension Agents, agronomists from area research centers and plant breeders serve in ex officio capacity to the association at district and state levels. On the county level, the Williams County Agricultural Association serves as the link between the state association and local approved contract growers who desire participation in the seed increase program.

Much of our district's business was spent on having reports from such folks as the State Seed Department, NDSU Development Foundation and the director of the seed increase program. I was especially interested in hearing Joel Ransom, NDSU Extension Agronomist, share his thoughts on the many hard spring wheat, durum, winter

wheat and barley varieties. There are 43 hard spring varieties listed in the North Dakota Hard Red Spring Wheat Variety Trial Tests for 2012 and Selection Guide. Nearly one-half have been released to the public in the past five years. According to Ransom, the top yielding varieties in the western half of North Dakota were Advance, Velva, RB07, Norden, Brennen, Barlow, and Rolag. When he showed us the quality data these varieties tended to flip-flop. It is difficult to identify one variety which has both yield and quality. Ransom did draw attention to a new variety named Elgin. This new release has only two years of data collected by the research centers across North Dakota. Ransom feels Elgin will do best in western North Dakota.

For durum, the relationship between yield and quality is similar to hard spring wheat but some of the recently released proven varieties have very good quality are also doing a pretty good job of competing for high yields on a statewide basis. For many years, Mountrail has been the variety of choice because of its yield. In a statewide basis, it still remains a top yielding variety but Alkabo, Grenora, and even Divide require a serious look because their yields have been very competitive since their release by NDSU in 2005. There is a newer variety, Carpio, which has incredible gluten strength and is competitive for yield. If you are looking for a variety for high protein Stronfield certainly has an edge. It is a 2004 Canada release.

Based on the 2012 growing season, we probably should pay attention to varieties which give some protection against scab. Those include Divide, Carpio, and Alkabo.

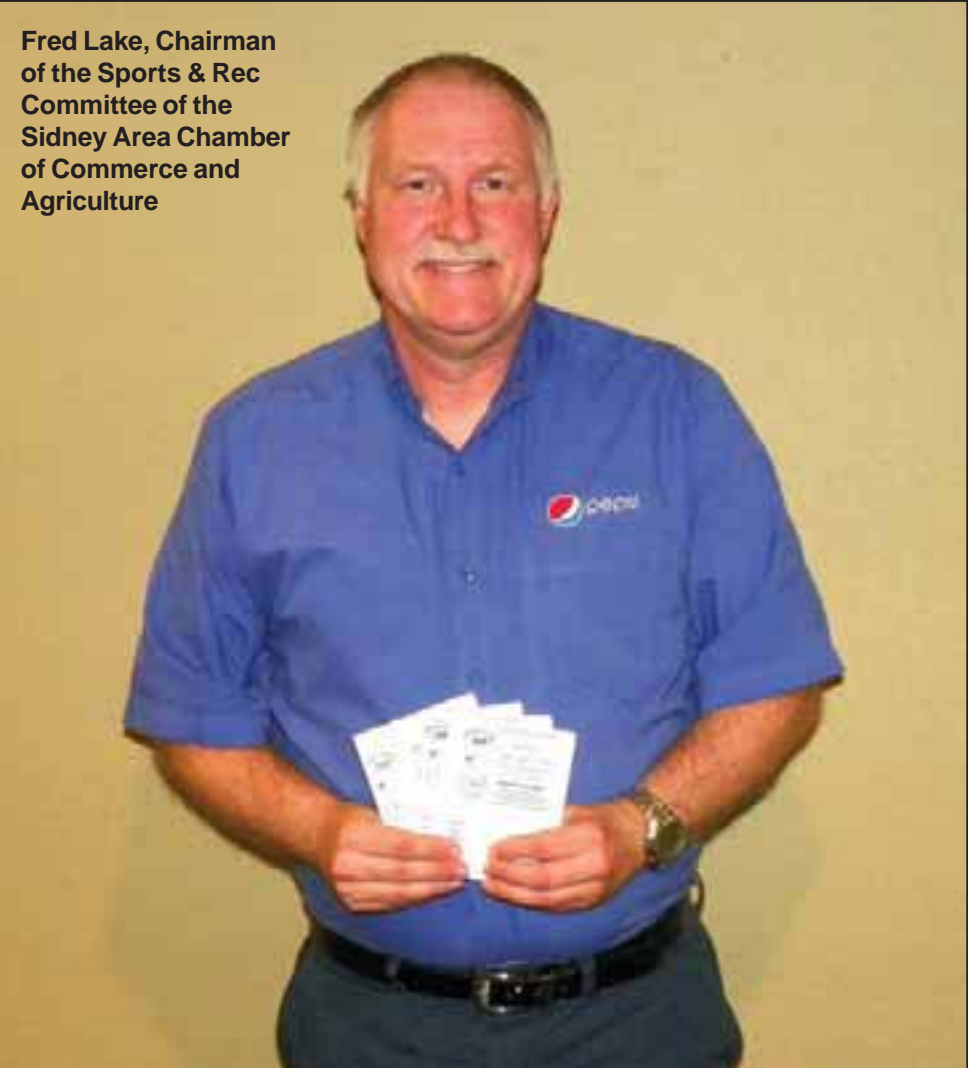
