## Last Chance To "E-Rase Your E-Waste" For 2011

Volunteers sought to help with final collection event.



Volunteers of all ages help package e-waste for shipping at the June "E-raise your E-waste" collection event. Volunteers interested in helping at the upcoming Friday and Saturday e-waste collection – even for just an hour or two – are encouraged to call Jackie Couture at 406-433-9422.

After collecting 46,062 lbs. of e-waste during its first four summer mini events, the area "E-raise your E-waste" e-cycling team is ready to close out the season with a record-setting bang at their annual weekend collection Friday and Saturday in Sidney.

"That beats our second highest annual total and is only 1,000 lbs. below what we collected all of last year, which was our best year yet," Butch Renders, a member of the organizing team, said of the collections to date. "We'll easily break the record with our weekend event, which is when we typically get the biggest collection for the year. It's a convenient time for those doing fall cleaning, clearing out their basements and garages."

That weekend event is FREE and is set for this Friday and Saturday beginning at 8 a.m. both days and running until 6 p.m. on Friday and 1 p.m. on Saturday. The weekend collection is being held at the Richland County Shop, 2140 W. Holly, Sidney, next to the fairgrounds. Signs will be posted. UNICOR is again the e-cycler.

Renders and "E-raise your E-waste" Committee

Co-chairs Jackie Couture and Cindy Eleson encourage anyone interested to participate this weekend. "This is your last chance for 2011," Couture noted. "So if you have any old electronic items you want to get rid of bring them on down Friday and Saturday and we'll make sure they're recycled properly so they won't contribute to any potential environmental or human health hazards."

### Local Support Appreciated

This is the seventh year the group has been providing e-waste recycling events in the region, and organizers note they couldn't do it without the help of many organizations, businesses and individuals. In the past, several groups have provided funding for the event and to offset costs to participants when there was a recycling charge, Renders said, including Sidney Health Center, the city and county and others. Now that the event is free, several of those same businesses and others have been helping provide pallets, cardboard, gaylords and shrink wrap for packaging to aid the effort, Renders said. This year, those contributors

include Sidney Health Center, Sidney Sugars, and Anchor Drilling, Sidney and National Varco Oilwell and NAPA Auto Parts, Williston.

"And, of course, the county lets us use their shop and equipment for the event and to store all the e-waste collected until UNICOR can come and get it, which we really appreciate," Renders said. In addition, the Montana Department of Environmental Quality has provided additional funding annually for use in promoting the event, Couture noted.

### Volunteers Welcome!

And then there are the volunteers. "We really want to thank the RSVP program again for helping line up volunteers for this event," Couture said, "and this year we also want to thank the Sidney High School Key Club for their help at several of the summer collection events. We couldn't have done it without them."

The group has also had help in the past from Sidney High School students in Caryn Fehilly's web design class, Couture said, adding that two students in the class may also be available to help with this year's weekend event. "We definitely appreciate

their interest and, of course, welcome their assistance," she said.

But while help has been plentiful to date, both Couture and Renders noted that there's definitely room for more during the big weekend event. They encouraged anyone interested in helping out, even for just a couple hours, to contact Couture at 406-433-9422.

## Fort Union & Confluence Bird Count Set For Saturday

The Fort Union and Confluence Bird Count is set for Saturday, Sept. 10 from 8 a.m.-10:30 a.m.

It was said by the great western naturalist John James Audubon, "I never for a day gave up listening to the songs of our birds, or watching their peculiar habits, or delineating them in the best way I could." Fort Union had many explorers who came to the fort and experienced the natural history as well as the cultural history. Audubon used paintbrush and oils to produce world-renowned images of wild birds. You can enjoy these colorful creatures in person.

Newbies and veterans, adults and kids—come out and experience the natural beauty and sounds of birds in this area where two rivers carve out a unique ecosystem. Bird counts are a fun family event in which citizens lend eyes and ears to help us measure the health of our bird populations. At Fort Union, you will be inspired by a special guest, the former president Theodore Roosevelt.

Meet in the Fort Union parking lot at 8 a.m. Birds will be counted at Fort Union, then caravan 2.5 miles to the Missouri-Yellowstone Confluence Interpretive Center. At the Confluence Center you will view prize-winning bird photographs from the 2011 photo contest and whet your whistles and pacify your palates with breakfast treats! There will be a coloring contest for younger participants. All participants will receive a collectible bird count badge.

Learn the different bird calls and why the natural world is so important to humans. Guides Audrey Barnhart and Kerry Finsaas will take you into the world of the wild where you can see this habitat up close. "Record-high water and record-low mosquitoes provide great birding conditions," according to Barnhart. Finsaas warns, however, "there could be a few gnats out there, so repellent will be available."

Fort Union Trading Post and the Missouri Yellowstone Confluence Center are located 24 miles north of Sidney, and 25 miles southwest of Williston via Highway 1804. While here, visitors are encouraged to tour the reconstructed Fort Union Trading Post and enjoy the Missouri-Yellowstone Interpretive exhibits and trails.

You may have noticed something different about Sidney's city parks lately. There might be quite a few noticeable differences in the parks but one major difference is the "Tobacco Free Play Zone" and "No Alcohol Permitted" signs. What started as community concern,

turned into a question, and now is a reality.

Community members were becoming quite concerned with alcohol use and smoking in the public parks. During sports games and at the playgrounds people raised the question, "Are drinking and smoking what we want our children to see, and are we, as adults, sending a message to our youth that we need these substances to have fun?"

It is illegal to drink alco-

hol beverages in the city parks unless a permit is obtained from the city. It is also not permitted to smoke in the play zones. "Many community members know of the law and follow it but due to an increase in the community's population it was believed that a reminder placed in our parks was necessary," said Sidney City Council Member Rick Norby.

Due to the hard work and dedication of community members and city crews you

can now see the reminders for yourselves.

Signs may not seem like much, but it is the location of the signs and the message they are sending that is significant. Adults need to reinforce the idea that our youth don't need alcohol and tobacco to have fun. The "Tobacco Free Play Zone" and "No Alcohol Permitted" signs serve as a reminder to people of all ages. The community supports providing children with healthy, safe places to play.

# Dr. Dirt

## Green Side Up

If you dial 701-744-5759 you will hear a pleasant voice informing you that "Green Acres Sod Farm" is able and willing to take care of your sod needs. That is the voice of Josie Riedel. She might even tell you that sod provides "instant grassification." She does remind people, however, that you need to install sod "green side up" to have good results.

Josie's husband Richard got into the sod business back in 1986. They were living in Flathead Valley at the time. Richard saw that "there was a need" for quality sod, so he went to the local community college school for two years to learn about grass management. They started the "Tuff Turf Sod Farm" in Columbia Falls. It was a small operation, but it did well. They were both from eastern Montana, however, so when the Sidney sod farm (run by Forrest Markle) was closing, Richard realized that it was time for him to move his family and sod farm to this area.

The "Green Acres Sod Farm" has been in operation since 1995. It is located 2 1/2 miles north of Fairview on ND Highway 58. They initially grew only one acre of sod, had success, and then gradually increased their operation to the 52 acres that they now grow. It takes two years for a grass crop to be ready to cut and sell. Last year they sold about 20 acres. That's almost 900,000 square feet of sod! And their operation provides sod for Sidney, Williston, Fairview, Glendive and Dickinson.

Running a sod farm takes a lot of work. "It's a young man's game," Richard says. Fortunately he has his two sons to help him - Zyon (age 28) and Frankie (age 24). They also have a number of hired hands. They do get their winters off, though, which is when the boys work at other jobs and/or fix farm equipment.

Riedel uses 5 different varieties of Kentucky Blue Grass (KBG) to grow his sod. KBG is by far and away the country's most popular seed for residential lawns. This type of grass requires sunlight and water to thrive. It also requires good topsoil and fertilizer. Other grass varieties might grow under less ideal situations - but they all have one disadvantage or another. Fine Fescue produces a lot of thatch. Tall Fescue has a very wide blade. Buffalograss and Bluegrama grass grow in drought conditions, but they go dormant in the early fall, so their brown appearance is not well-suited for residen-

tial settings. Canada Bluegrass looks good when you are speeding by it on the highway, but it does not look good in your backyard.

There is an age old debate as to whether sod or seed is better for establishing a new lawn. Sod is more expensive to start with, but the results are - in my mind - well worth it. The thick mesh of sod helps to prevent weed growth. Either option (sod or seed) requires preparation work, contouring of the land, fertilizer, and lots of water to get established. I have been very impressed with the quality of the "Green Acres" sod that I have installed for my "Kessler Landscaping" clients. I am, by the way, just finishing a 15,000 square foot sod job on the north side of town. See attached picture. It is gratifying to see hard work result in an immediately appealing yard.

Laying sod is not rocket science. Google "laying sod" for specific instructions. I also think it is important to use good quality sod, do plenty of ground preparation work, and plan on doing several days of hard physical labor to get the job done. If you follow Josie Riedel's advice ("Green side up!") then the chances are that you will be happy with the results.

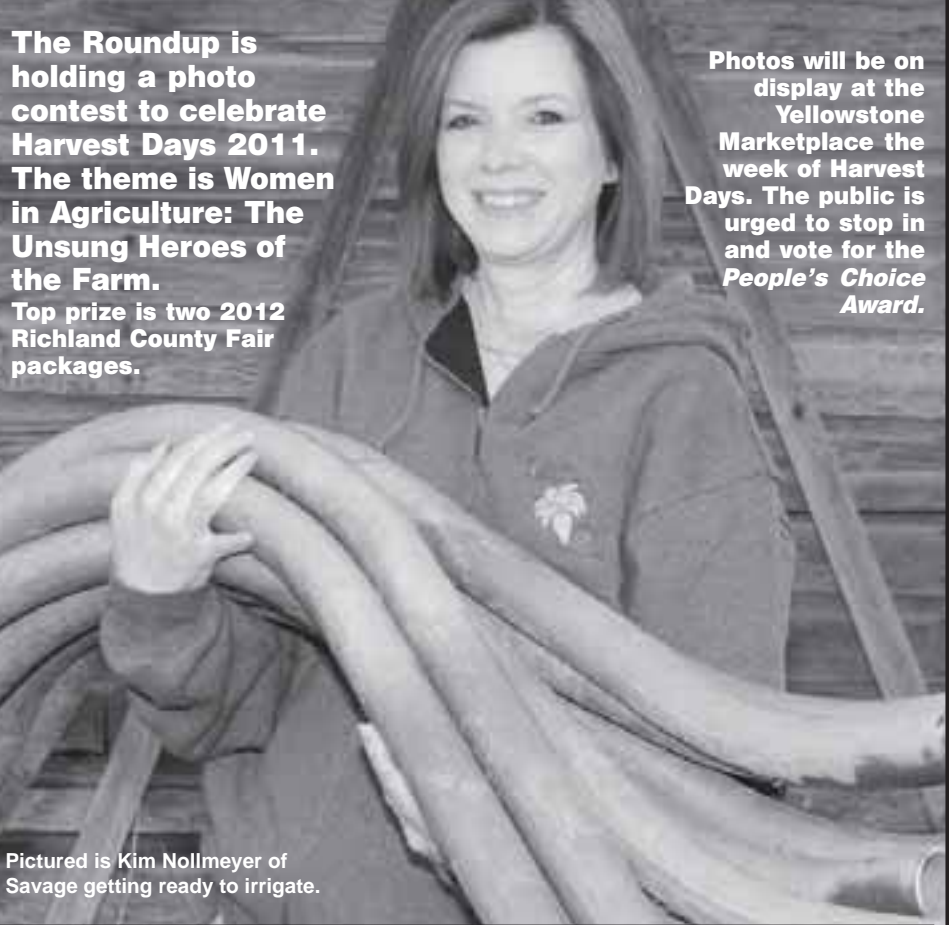

## Richland County Ambulance Service Offering First Responder Course

The Richland County Ambulance Service (RCAS) will be holding a First Responder course starting in early October for individuals interested in helping their community through the ambulance service.

As Eastern Montana continues to grow and change, it is critical for emergency medical services to be available at all times, in all locations. Richland County is fortunate to have ambulance services spread throughout the county and a dedicated volunteer team, but additional volunteers are always needed.

"The First Responder program has given more individuals an opportunity to be involved with the Richland County Ambulance Service and has brought some much needed relief to each of our services around the county," stated Josh King, RCAS director. "We hope that this course will continue to have a good turn out and add additional reinforcement to our volunteer service while still providing Richland County with the best care possible."

The First Responder course is designed to be a shorter time commitment than the EMT Basic class while retaining much of the crucial training involved, allowing them to become valuable assets on the ambulance. The course will cover a broad range of emergency medical subject matter, and will provide individuals with the knowledge to assist on the ambulance. Aside from classroom lessons, the course also focuses on hands-on skills stations that work to develop

teamwork skills and prepare students for real life emergency situations.

People of all ages and backgrounds are encouraged to sign up for the upcoming course. Classes will be held for three hours at a time, two days a week. The course will offer interested individuals the chance to learn the skills of emergency medicine through a more conducive time schedule. Becoming a first responder will require 54 hours of training, spanning about eight weeks. Upon completion first responders will have the option to take a course that transitions them into the EMT Basic level.

An EMT's job is to respond to medical emergency situations, treat and stabilize the patient on scene and in transport, and to deliver the patient to the hospital for additional care. First responders' primary job is to drive the ambulance, and assist with patient care at the scene. This will allow the opportunity to gain real-world experience in the field, while the EMT Basics can focus their attention primarily on patient care during transport.

It is expected that one to two months after this First Responder class is finished there will be a course that transitions First Responders to the EMT Basic level. Participants must have completed the First Responder course before they can enroll in the EMT Basic course.

"We really appreciate anyone that can put in their time and effort," said Lana Whitney, Ambulance Service EMT. "You will be an asset to our communities. It is an important and rewarding job."

"Not all calls are dire emergencies, but each call demands the same level of professionalism and compassion," stated King. "We function as strongly as we do because we stand together as a service. In the field, our individuality gives us versatility but our team work gives us strength. We are doing great but we do need more help."

EMS is a genuinely rewarding and exciting field that provides individuals with the chance to make a real difference in people's lives. Individuals interested in training to become a First Responder should call the Richland County Ambulance Service at 406-488-2180 to reserve an interview session.
