When you take care of yourself, everyone benefits.

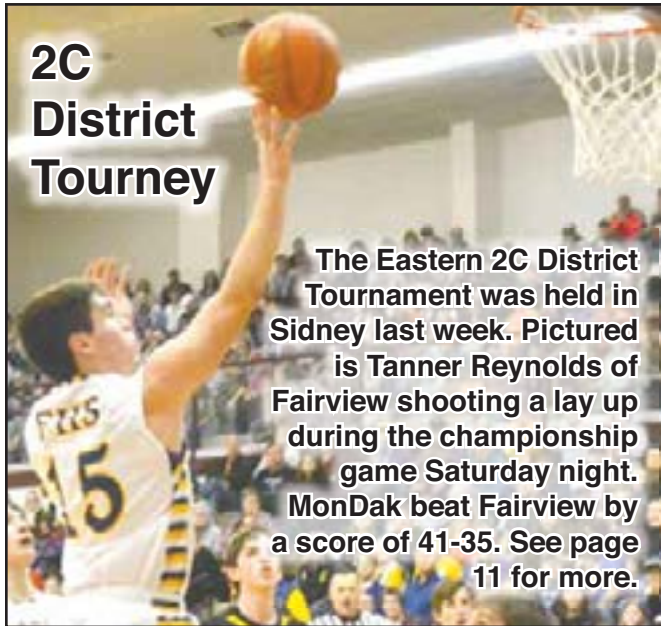

Through With Chew Week Feb. 19 – 25

“Through With Chew” is an effort to call attention to the use of smokeless tobacco. Smokeless tobacco includes chewing tobacco products like Skoal, Snus, RedMan, and are often flavored to appeal to young users. According to the Youth Risk Behavior Survey in 2015, 25.2% of male high school seniors in Montana use smokeless tobacco. This public awareness campaign is designed to reduce the use of smokeless tobacco among young people. Smokeless tobacco is not a safe alternative to cigarettes, as some young people believe, and it is even more habit forming because it contains a higher concentration of nicotine than cigarettes. Smokeless tobacco can cause oral cancer, especially in the cheeks, gums and throat. In addition, smokeless tobacco is addicting. It can also lead to other problems, from heart disease and pancreatic cancer, to other dental problems, such as mouth sores, gum recession, tooth decay, bad breath, and permanent discoloration of teeth.

Through With Chew week is sponsored by the Richland County Health Department and the Partnership for Promise Coalition. Are you ready to call it quits from smokeless or spit tobacco or any other type of tobacco? The Montana Tobacco Quit Line is a free service available to all Montanans who would like to quit using smokeless or other tobacco products. Child Find/Preschool Screening in Sidney

Sidney Public Schools will be conducting their annual child find/preschool screening clinic for children ages 0-6, excluding kindergarten students at Central School, 200 3rd Ave. SE. The dates and times are as follows, 2:30-7:30 p.m., Monday, February 27, Tuesday, February 28, Monday, March 6 and Tuesday, March 7.

The purpose of the child find/preschool screening program is to identify those children who may need educational, medical, or other types of assistance for problems or handicaps that may not have been detected.

School special services personnel will be conducting the screening assisted by an audiologist, Hi Line Homes and the Richland County Health Department. Hearing, vision, speech/ language, motor skills, and cognitive development will be among the areas checked.

To have your child included in the screening, appointments are necessary and will be taken by calling the Administration Office at 433-4080 during school hours.

You are encouraged to bring your child even if they attended last year. The screening is provided at no cost as a public service of the Sidney Public Schools.

Sexual Health Awareness Month

February is traditionally known as the month of love and romance. However, along with roses and chocolate comes the need to make well-informed choices about relationships and sexuality. That is why February has been deemed Sexual Health Awareness Month. Sexual health is an important part of the overall health and wellbeing of all people in the community, from the young to the old, irrespective of whether a person has or ever will be sexually active.

The need for more information in sexual relationships is apparent in Montana’s young adults. In 2015, 25% of all reported Chlamydia cases were between the ages of 15-19. Regardless of race or gender, data show that sexually active teens and young adults are at an increased risk for STDs when compared to older adults. The good news is that most STDs are treatable, and many are curable – early detection through testing is key. Yet, stigma, inconsistent or incorrect condom use, lack of access to health care, and a combination of other factors contribute to high rates of STDs among teens and young adults.

When my family and I moved back to Montana in 2012, I never dreamed I would have the opportunity to help carry out something as essential as regional water. The thought hadn't crossed my mind primarily because I had been off living in heavily-populated areas since leaving Circle. I had quickly grown very accustomed to the great quality water that was found seemingly everywhere. I'm embarrassed to admit it, but I had become thoroughly desensitized to the struggles with such an important resource because I didn't see them every day.

About DRWA: For those who may not be familiar with the project, Dry-Redwater Regional Water Authority (DRWA) is one of four Regional Water Systems in Montana formed to address the serious water needs in our area. At full build out, an estimated 26,500 people will be serviced in the DRWA project area, which includes the towns of Circle, Richey, Jordan, Glendive, Sidney, and Fairview, the unincorporated towns of Lambert, Savage, Bloomfield, Brockway, Brusett, Cohagen, Lindsey, Sand Springs, and Vida, the water districts of Highland Park, Forrest Park, Spring Grove, and Whispering Trees, and rural users in the counties of McCone, Dawson, Garfield, Richland, and Prairie. Dry-Redwater was formed by local Conservation Districts, is registered as a water and sewer district with the Montana Secretary of State's office, and is governed by a Board of Directors with representation from throughout the service area. At full build out, DRWA intends to have a single water treatment plant and intake near North Fork Rock Creek on the Fort Peck Reservoir.

Unfortunately, all forward progress came to a halt when the Rural Water Supply Act was signed into Law on December 22, 2006 authorizing the establishment of a specific rural water program within the Bureau of Reclamation. At that time, DRWA was told BOR would need to take a break from review of the DRWA project and develop new program criteria before any work could continue.

They Want to Hear from You:

Let our Congressional Delegates know Regional Water in Montana needs to be a priority. Ask them to assist us by introducing our Legislation sooner rather than later.

Don't Get Discouraged: We are always looking at additional options for providing water as we continue working toward federal authorization. A number of alternatives have been identified and we are moving on planning engineering to identify which bring the most benefit to the service area. Preliminary engineering has begun on multiple potential areas. Near Circle, DRWA is working on the ability to provide water service along Highway 13, North Road, Horse Creek Road, Highway 200, and residential services near the edge of town. In the Sidney area, Dry-Redwater has goals to expand service

It is extremely important for DRWA to have accurate data regarding those who are interested in being connected so our efforts are maximized. Dry-Redwater Regional Water Authority had a chance to travel to Helena at the end of January to discuss the importance of Montana Regional Water Systems. We were part of a Legislative Meet & Greet where 49 Legislators attended to discuss important issues from around the state. In addition, we had the opportunity to testify in front of the Long-Range Planning Committee about funding specific to DRWA and other like projects. All conversations went very well and DRWA appears to have support at the state level, but Legislators still need to hear from you.
