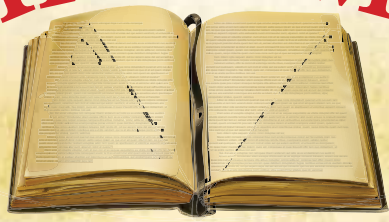

Good to Glow Mobile Spray Tanning. Dotson will come to your home, or welcome you at Temple Tattoo Gallery, 108 S. Central, Sidney.

After deciding in March, 2018 that she wanted to do spray tanning, Dotson did a lot of research, took on line classes and became certified by the National Spray Tanning Professional Association, where you can look up her credentials by her last name. She then practiced for months on willing friends. "It was nice to have that time to become good at it," Dotson said. She

learned how certain body parts absorb the solution, what might be causing certain issues, as well how to perfectly spray the solution.

The tanning solution is also based, vegan, and PETA approved which is a much higher quality solution than an alcohol based one. "It's better for your skin and helps the tan stay longer," Dotson explained.

Dotson provides pre-tan and after tan instructions, which are critical for a great tan that will last. Tanners are given breathable nose filters, hair nets, paper undergarments and eye protection.

Tanning is available by appointment only, with mornings, afternoons and evenings available, including some weekends. Sessions are only \$25 in shop or \$35 in home with a \$10 travel fee outside Sidney. Get your friends together for a group discount and only one travel fee. Tans only take about 30 minutes in the shop or 45 in home, including set up and take down. Overspray is contained with the pop-up tent, so tanning is not messy. Follow up is always welcome with Dotson available for any questions or issues. "I want to know of any concerns," she emphasized. "A slight adjustment is usually all it takes to correct any problem areas for future tans."

Professor Tom Isern Book Signing at the Pioneer Museum Dec. 6

The Pioneer Museum of McKenzie County, located in the Long X Visitor Center, 100 2nd Ave SW, Watford City, ND will host the author of Pacing Dakota, Professor Thomas D. Isern, for a booktalk and autograph session on Thursday, December 6, 2018. The author will be in the house from 3 to 7 p.m. to meet readers and sign books for purchasers. At 4 p.m. and 6 p.m. Prof. Isern will present a booktalk and reading, which also will include original song based on stories in the book. The book will be available at the museum gift shop as well as Pride of Dakota refreshments.

Isern is Professor of History and University Distinguished Professor at North Dakota State University, where he has served since 1992. Pacing Dakota is his seventh book. The publisher of the work is North Dakota State University Press (ndsupress.org).

Pacing Dakota was published in July by NDSU Press and has received enthusiastic response from readers and reviewers alike. "Dr. Isern is no stranger to the prairie," observes the High Plains Reader; he searches out "real things in real places" and makes it his habit "to follow the road less travelled."

Betsy Jameson, former president of the Western History Association, says, "Pacing Dakota is the work of a consummate regional historian and firmly-rooted plainsman. The work is sensate, literate, socially rooted, and thoughtfully situated. It is a book to savor."

People across the northern plains know Isern for his voice in the radio feature, Plains Folk, heard weekly on Prairie Public. Pacing Dakota came together as a collection of sketches, drawing on radio scripts written to read on radio. Somewhere in the process, as the author wrote transitions and added reflections, looking back on forty years as a working historian and regional author, the work crossed the line into the domain of memoir. The narrative transitions from the close confines of historical archives into the prairie landscapes of the northern plains. It speaks with the mingled voices of scholarly historian, outdoor sportsman, culinary enthusiast, lifelong Lutheran, and prairie farmboy.

"This book might have been called My Life on the Plains," Isern jokes, "but that title was taken! I am a storyteller. The stories in Pacing Dakota come from all over the state. But I'm sixty-six years old, I have lived all my life on the plains, and so I am part of the story, too."

Pacing Dakota is available locally from the Pioneer Museum of McKenzie County. The book also can be purchased from independent bookstores across the region, direct from NDSU Press at ndsupress.org, or from other online booksellers.

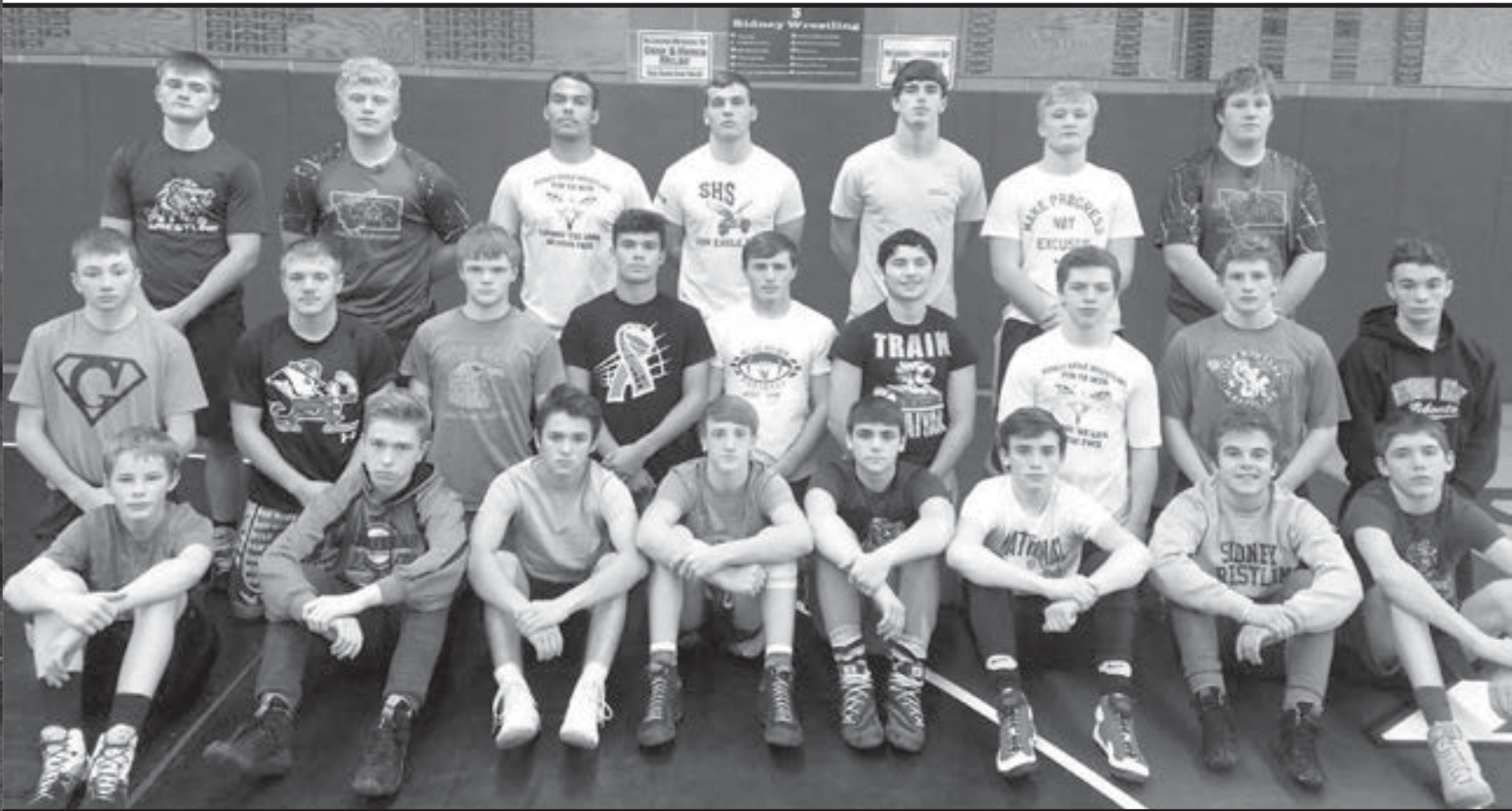

MDT Seeks Input on New Intersection Design North of Fairview

Public encouraged to weigh-in through online survey and public meeting

Sidney, Mont.- Roadway users will have an opportunity to weigh-in on potential improvements to Highway 201 (MT-201) west of Fairview through an online survey launched by the Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) this week or a public meeting on Nov. 29 at the Fairview Senior Center.

The efforts are being undertaken by MDT to garner feedback on a proposed reconstruction project aimed at improving safety along MT-201 and alleviating the impact of commercial truck traffic on the town of Fairview.

The project, known as Fairview West, would reconstruct 6 miles of highway west of Fairview, including 2 miles of brand new alignment between the airport and North Dakota border. To accommodate the new alignment, a separate intersection would be constructed at the junction of MT-201/ MT-200 north of the existing intersection near Interstate Avenue.

Survey respondents are asked to rank their priorities for the new intersection among

choices like safety, value, and construction impacts. The next question allows respondents to rate different scenarios on a five-star scale and provide feedback on each one. At the end, users are asked questions about how frequently they travel in the area and what type of vehicle they drive.

“MDT wants to understand how local residents use the roadways, so we can deliver a safe and efficient intersection that makes sense for the community,” said Wade Salyards, adding that feedback from the survey and public meeting will help MDT select one of 3 possible configurations for the new intersection.

Salyards said the project team is also interested in learning if there are additional configurations outside of the identified alternatives that could meet the project’s objectives.

According to MDT, MT-201 was first identified for improvement in response to a large influx in traffic volumes, especially commercial truck traffic related to Bakken oil

development, and the desire to improve safety by bringing the roadway up to current standards.

Over a 10-year period the segment proposed for reconstruction experienced 91 reported crashes, including 1 fatality and 5 incapacitating injuries. Off road right, rollover, and embankment crashes were among the main trends, indicating a high potential for crash reduction through reconstruction.

The project is in the preliminary design phase and is expected to be ready for construction by 2022.

For those who would prefer to provide feedback in-person, a public meeting is scheduled for Thurs. Nov. 29 from 5:00-7:00 pm at the Fairview Senior Center (217 5th St. W).



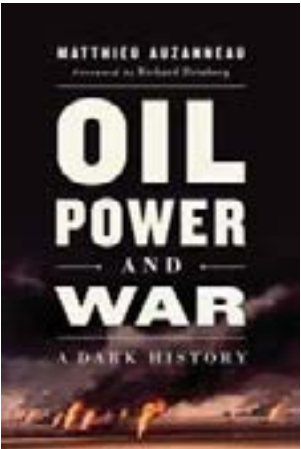
