Taylem Berry Still Missing Almost Two Months After His Abduction

A chair stood empty this past Thanksgiving Day. A family ate without their youngest member but was filled with hopes and prayers for his safe return.

On Oct. 9 Autumn Jorstad met with Raymond Berry in the Sidney Reynolds parking lot to get their 4-year-old son, Taylem Berry, back. There was an argument and Jorstad's nightmare began. Berry picked up Taylem, put him on his shoulders, and walked away. Jorstad tried to call Berry to talk to him or Taylem but he never answered and eventually disconnected his service. Jorstad was discouraged from contacting the police but she eventually did tell them on Oct. 18. She said, "Everybody kept telling me that there was nothing they could do. Everybody was wrong and it cost Taylem a week." Sidney Police did a welfare check on Berry and found that he had moved out of his apartment. Further investigation found that he had quit his job around the time he took Taylem. According to www.missingkids.org, on Oct. 27 a felony warrant for custodial interference was issued for Berry. On Nov. 2 a BOLO was issued about Taylem's abduction and it began circulating on social media. On Nov. 9, Jorstad was interviewed on Williston Trending Topics News Radio about Talem's abduction. As of Thanksgiving Day, no Amber Alert has been issued for Taylem. According to missingkids.org, they are activated in the most serious child abduction cases.

Taylem is 3'6" and 39 lbs. He has brown eves and. at the time of his abduction, had blonde hair and a wiry build. He may be going by the name of Ragnor AllFather Berry. Berry is a 39-year-old Army veteran. He is 5'9" and 200 lbs with brown hair, brown eyes, and a stocky build at the time of the abduction. Berry may have untreated PTSD and, at times, is suicidal. According to Jorstad, it was giving him trouble last year and he told her that he "Barely feels he has control of his mind". She said he had threatened

to take Taylem many times since his conception. Berry is a former truck driver, has survival training, and owns MREs, a water purification system, gold, and silver. He loves to camp



Sidney/Fairview to Host **Eagle Wrestling Tournament**

The Sidney/Fairview wrestling team is holding their annual Eagle Wrestling Tournament Dec. 2 & 3. Wrestling action will begin at 8:30 a.m. Friday and 9 a.m. Saturday. Friday will begin with all duals. There will be 10 mats running simultaneously. There will be six mats at the high school with top 16 seated teams and four mats at Central Elementary with the 15 lower seated teams. Championship duals will begin at 2:45 p.m. Friday with the first round of individual tournament beginning at 5:30 p.m. Friday night. The individual tournament will continue beginning at 9 a.m. Saturday with the championship starting at approximately 5 p.m.

Teams from 8 different states will be represented at this year's tournament. In addition to a slew of Montana and North Dakota teams, wrestlers from Poway, CA; Adam City, CO; Post Falls, ID; Lake Stevens, WA; Oak Harbor, OH and Rapid City Central, SD will be competing at the tournament. There will be a total of 31 teams at the event.

Sidney/Fairview will be defending their Montana state championship streak of 5 years this season. Returning placers include Gordon Knapp, Ben Carlson and Kaden Wise. Returning state champions include Reece Graves, Owen Lonski, Zander Dean and Amaiya Kirn. Also starting this year

8th grade students will be eligible to wrestle at the high school level in Montana. Currently Sidney/Fairview has four middle school wrestlers practicing with the high school team. "We have been trying to get this through for years and years and finally got it this year. We've had so many 8th graders come through that could have wrestled for us," said head coach Guy Melby. "Now we are going to be able to do it."

Melby is confident Sidney/Fairview will have another successful season. "I'm pretty impressed with our senior leadership and how hard everyone is working. It's pretty exciting," stated Melby.

MDU Applying To Increase Rates

On Nov. 4, Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. filed an application with the Montana Public Service Commission for Authority to Establish Increased Rates for Electric Service.

In it, MDU proposes a total increase of \$10,499,415. This will affect the rates of about 25,600 customers and bring their rates up 19.2%. MDU also is asking for an interim rate relief of \$1,716,219. MDU is saying the current electricity rates are unjust, unreasonable, and do not allow MDU to fully recover the cost of providing electric service to its Montana customers.

Positive Influenza Cases In Richland County

Richland County's flu season has begun with five residents testing positive for Influenza last week. The results were PCR confirmed for Influenza A at the Sidney Health Center Laboratory. One was hospitalized. The cases include four adults and one child. None of them were vaccinated.

The symptoms of influenza are sudden onset of fever, chills, fatigue, body aches, headache, chest discomfort and a cough. A person may experience all or most of these symptoms. You may catch influenza or the "flu" when you breathe in the virus from someone else's cough or when you touch a surface with the virus on it (such as a phone or faucet) and then touch your nose, mouth or eyes. The risk of infection from influenza is higher in crowded public areas and living quarters. Persons begin to show symptoms within a week of being exposed to the virus.

Richland County Health Department encourages residents to get a flu shot from the health department, a local healthcare provider or pharmacy.

Vaccination remains the best prevention for influenza and influenza related complications. Influenza vaccine is recommended for everyone from ages 6 months and older. Persons who have any chronic health condition (diabetes, heart disease, cancers, immune suppressed, pregnant, have compromised lung/respiratory diseases, etc.) are at higher risk of complications from influenza illness and are strongly urged to get yearly influenza vaccinations.

All flu vaccines for the 2022-2023 season are quadrivalent vaccines, designed to protect against four different flu viruses, including two influenza A viruses and two influenza B viruses. Different vaccines are licensed for use in different age groups, and some vaccines are not recommended for

some groups of people.

In addition to vaccination please take precautions to limit the spread of disease, including:

• Wash your hands thoroughly and frequently.

• Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when coughing or sneezing.

 Stay home from work, school, daycare, and large gatherings when you're sick.

Get plenty of rest; andEat nutritious foods

and drink plenty of fluids.







This last July 4th Richland County 4-H members competed in the state 4-H Livestock Judging Contest at Montana 4-H Congress held in Bozeman on the Montana State University campus. The four members were Jori Horsburgh, Garrett Larson, Landry Larson and Marett Schieber. The team competed against teams from all over the state of Montana. The team placed second in the state. The top team from the contest at Montana 4-H Congress earns an opportunity to represent the state at the Western National Roundup, which is held in Denver, CO in conjunction with the National Western Stock Show. However, each team can only represent Montana once, the team that placed first this year attended the event last year. The team from Richland County has been busy practicing and preparing to proudly

compete at the Roundup for the state. Their coaches, Laura Schieber and Rachael Oliver have been working with youth to further develop their skills and gain more experience in judging livestock. The team is ready to hit the road and honored to compete at the Roundup Jan. 4-7, 2023, in Denver.

Livestock judging is a competitive event where youth observe livestock and evaluate them based on commonly accepted standards brought forth by the livestock industry. In the livestock judging contest youth not only evaluate and rank a class of livestock, but then must defend their choices by giving a set of oral reasons to a judge. When youth participate in livestock judging they gain skills that aid them in the livestock industry. Youth who participate in this activity learn livestock breeds, learn the traits that produce a quality animal and product, gain the understanding of desirable characteristics and faults of livestock, and appreciate the value of comparing livestock based on their quality and merit. In addition to preparing these youth for a future in the livestock industry, youth gain life skills from livestock judging that will aid them in all areas of their life. These skills include but are not limited to: decision making, organization, confidence, oral communication, time management, critical thinking and gain the value of appreciating others' opinions.
