Treat 'em or eat 'em: Insect Talk Looks At Future Management Options

For centuries, mankind has battled insect pests with varying levels of success, and today is no different. While the advent of new chemical controls in the past century has aided management, concern for its impact on the environment and other desirable species means scientists are still searching for better, safer and more effective options, some of which even include turning a pest into a product. Come discover new high-tech options emerging to manage age-old insect pests, and others not so lofty (like eating them!) in the second of two special, plain language, family-friendly talks set for Thursday, Nov. 21, at 7 pm at the USDA-ARS Northern Plains Agricultural Research Laboratory (NPARK) in Sidney in celebration of its 50th anniversary. In Thursday's talk, our presenter Insect Pathologist Stefan Jaronski will peek into the future to determine how new insect management research underway today is likely to evolve over the next 50 years.

Dr. Jaronski's presentation is entitled "What Does the Future Hold for Insect Pest Management?" and includes related displays of live insects, and, yes, even a few recipes featuring you-know-what! Also available following that evening's presentation are more traditional refreshments, as well as tours of the research lab for anyone interested. In keeping with the family friendly focus, NPARK employees will also be providing free childcare onsite for the youngest members of the family (toddlers through lower elementary grades) so their parents can take in the talks with their older children without having to find a babysitter. Childcare activities include special age-appropriate treats, games and other activities featuring an insect theme. Please join us for this interesting and fun evening beginning at 7 pm on Thursday, Nov. 21. The lab is located at 1500 N. Central in Sidney. Sidney Health Center Receives Quality Award

Sidney Health Center was recently awarded the Montana Rural Healthcare Performance Improvement Network's Quality Improve-

ment Award for its work on reducing preventable readmissions. The awards were announced during the general session at the MHA Annual Convention held in Billings on September 26, 2013.

The Montana Rural Healthcare Performance Im-

provement Network (PIN) is a voluntary membership of 48 critical access hospitals throughout the state. Through this Network, member hospitals are able to benchmark their performance with their peers on a variety of financial, utilization and direct

patient care measures that encourage safe, effective, patient-centered care delivery in even the most remote communities of the state. PIN quality of care measures are based on national benchmarks, but are tailored to reflect the realities of the state's rural population.

Throughout 2012 and 2013, PIN members worked in one or more of four focus areas to improve the quality of care provided to the members of their communities: improving chest pain, heart failure and acute myocardial infarction care; reducing preventable readmissions; reducing pressure ulcers and falls; and improving stroke care. Applicants for awards in 2013 were required to demonstrate consistent participation in the PIN's benchmarking program and measurable improvement in two or more of the quality of care focus areas over the previous 12 months.

Sidney Health Center has demonstrated a commitment to its community and the region it serves through its efforts to participate in the PIN's benchmarking and quality of care improvement programs. Peggy Kopp and Nancy Dynneson received

the award for the facility at the Performance Improvement Network's regional meeting held recently at the Regional Performance Improvement Network Meeting.

Retired Teacher Loves New Career

Retired Sidney teacher Bernie Braden has found a new career and is absolutely loving it. As Coordinator for the Literacy Volunteers for Adults- Richland County, she is now tutoring adults who are determined to achieve their GED. “The neatest thing about this program is that it is all student centered, according to their needs and learning style and where they’re most comfortable,” she said. “There’s a big difference between 1on 1 tutoring and a public school classroom. Some people just don’t thrive in a classroom setting.” Currently there are 8 GED students and about 9 English as a Second Language students in the LVA program. Braden tutors the GED students herself. “I’m selfish,” she said laughing. “I love it and I don’t want to give them up.” Braden praised the work of all the volunteers with LVA and is glad to be able to help in a big way. “All the tutors have worked so hard. I have a lot of time to devote to the students.” There is room for 5 to 8 more. “I enjoy working with all my students and I would love to have more,” she said.

Braden feels very fortunate to have 2 Spanish speaking ladies to tutor the English as a Second Language students. Gloria Reyna teaches the basic level students while Chris Durfey tutors those who can speak English but need more skills. Braden said it was a real blessing when Durfey, who has done missionary work in South America, walked in her door. “Both ladies really care about helping the students step forward and work hard to find new ways to reach the students. I don’t know what I would do without them, I don’t speak Spanish!”

Students requiring tutoring in math have an excellent resource at Kahn Academy which Braden found through the website discussion board sponsored by ProLiteracy, the national organization which sponsors and certifies LVA.

Through the Kahn Academy, students are pre-tested. Then all the lessons are individually based on that pre-test. Problems are on a blackboard, followed by videos on solving the problem. Students can go all the way from 1st grade through pre-calculus. “It’s very rewarding,” Braden said. “You can watch as the skills are mastered and see their progress, one skill at a time.” Braden finds this one on one approach takes the ‘intimidation factor’ out of math. The students can work at home, or at the library and Braden can monitor exactly where they’re at in the program. It also eases the burden on volunteers which are hard to find in this busy community. Braden is delighted that Stockman Bank has agreed to donate a laptop to LVA which will enable students to work on Kahn Academy whenever they are in for classes. They can only work on library computers during library hours. “We don’t work library hours. This is a real bonus for us,” Braden said.

LVA is sponsored by ProLiteracy and works closely with The Montana Office of Public Instruction. The LVA board strictly follows the standards and rules set by those organizations. Braden finds ProLiteracy helpful with curriculum changes and with resources such as the discussion board. Working with both entities, LVA is moving away from a GED. Although students will get a diploma, LVA is not using GED materials. Instead they are joining the national movement toward Common Core and using HiSet Educational Testing

services to follow Common Core more directly. Although the math may be a bit more difficult, Braden feels that the rest of the courses are much the same as before. She encourages adults to contact LVA for help getting through the course. “You need us,” she emphasized. “Don’t do it alone.” LVA has practice tests for the students to take periodically. “I strongly suggest that people come and spend some time and get some tutoring with me,” she said. “I love these students. I loved teaching in a classroom too, but this is different. I had a Kahn Academy student in here who ‘got’ a math concept and cried. I cried with him. It’s so gratifying to help open some of those doors. It’s very rewarding.”

Braden was born and raised in Wibaux, Mont. She received her bachelor’s degree from Dickinson State with a double major in English and Theatre. She truly appreciates the education she received in Dickinson praising it as one of the best education colleges in the nation. That education

prepared her for 2 years in Rugby, N.D. followed by a career spent mostly at Sidney High School beginning in 1979. She left briefly in 1983 when her husband was transferred and spent a year teaching at a junior high school in New Mexico, an experience she treasures. She learned about Native American cultures and how students can be marginalized. “It really opened my eyes and helped me, particularly in later years, with all the changes going on in Sidney. It made it easier for me to understand the changes that these kids are going through.” Braden came back to Sidney in 1985 and retired from Communication Arts 10 in 2013. During the early years, she also directed plays and was a speech and drama coach.

Braden brings all those years of experience with her to LVA. “I want to bring this program back to the thriving program it was under Sue Zimmerman,” she stated. Anyone interested in enriching their lives through the LVA program is encouraged to call Braden at 406 480-1971.

Watford City Housing Supported By McKenzie County Bank

A McKenzie County Bank contribution to the North Dakota Housing Incentive Fund (HIF) will support affordable housing developments in Watford City.

“McKenzie County Bank has always been a strong supporter of our community, and the decision to contribute to essential services housing using the HIF program was an easy one. These housing projects are critical to our community in order to provide housing for the people who will meet the needs of our growing population,” said Scott Swenson, CEO of McKenzie County Bank.

Capitalized by contributions from state taxpayers, HIF provides developers of rental housing with low-cost financing if units are set-aside for essential service workers and low- to moderate-income

households. North Dakota Housing Finance Agency (NDHFA) administers the program. The North Dakota Industrial Commission, consisting of Gov. Jack Dalrymple as chairman, Agriculture Commissioner Doug Goehring and Attorney General Wayne Stenehjem, oversees the agency.

McKenzie County Bank contributed \$145,000 to HIF in September splitting the funds between Wolf Run Village, a recently completed townhome complex for city and county employees, teachers and law enforcement personnel, and a McKenzie County Healthcare Systems development that will house hospital employees.

“Housing shortages and increased costs in energy-impacted areas make it difficult for government agencies and medical facilities to recruit

and retain personnel,” said Jolene Kline, NDHFA acting executive director. “I’d like to thank McKenzie County Bank for supporting the needs of its home community.”

The Industrial Commission oversees the state’s housing development efforts and urged the legislature to reauthorize HIF during the 2013 session. NDHFA received a \$15.4 million general fund appropriation to support the program and was authorized to further capitalize HIF by issuing \$20 million in state tax credits.

“Housing our workforce and individuals and families of modest means continues to be one of North Dakota’s top priorities,” said Kline. “By contributing to HIF, businesses and individuals help address the need and have a say in how their tax dollars are spent.”

Including the Watford

City developments, 18 housing projects received funding commitments from NDHFA this summer. The agency is currently reviewing additional development applications and will make more commitments very soon.

Contributions can be targeted to a specific project or designated for general use in a community or region. Individuals and businesses

contributing to the fund receive a dollar-for-dollar state tax credit.

Land Use Regulations Series — Did You Know? Agricultural Covenant

Richland County is enriched with a vast number of farms that are also located in the irrigated valley along the county’s eastern boundary. Throughout Richland County the majority of the land is agricultural.

Over the years many parcels or lots were created using an agricultural exemption from Montana’s subdivision laws. Why? Because an agricultural exemption is a quick and easy way to divide off a parcel. However, to use the agricultural exemption, agricultural covenants are placed on these parcels.

Agricultural covenants are placed on the parcels pursuant to State statute Title 76 “Land Resources and Use” Chapter 3 “Local Regulations of Subdivision” Part 207(1)(c) “to divisions made outside of platted subdivisions by gift, sale, or agreement to buy and sell in which the parties to the transaction enter a covenant running with the land and revocable only by mutual consent of the governing body and the property owner that the divided land will be used exclusively for agricultural purposes”.

Prior to development or construction of a parcel you will need to find out whether or not the parcel has an agricultural covenant due to the fact that these parcels can only be used exclusively for agricultural purposes.

If the parcel has an agricultural covenant, in order to change the land use it will need to go through the subdivision review process. Pursuant to State statute Title 76 “Land Resources and Use” Chapter 3 “Local Regulations of Subdivision” Part 207(2)(b) “a change in use of the land exempted under subsection (1)(c) for anything other than agricultural purposes subjects the division to review under parts 5 and 6 of this chapter”.

Part 5 outlines the process and requirements the local government follows to adopt subdivision regulations. Part 6 outlines the subdivision review process.

The Richland County Subdivision Regulations as adopted by the Board of Richland County Commission are available at the Office of Richland County Planner and on the Richland County website at www.richland.org.

Building in Richland County

When do I need a construction permit?

A construction permit is needed for all new construction. In many cases a permit is needed for repair or replacement of existing fixtures. A plumbing, electrical, or mechanical permit is needed for any addition or changes to a building's existing system and new construction. If you are unsure whether or not your project needs a permit please call Alton Hillesland at (406) 433-2809 or the State of Montana Building Division at (406) 841-2056.

When don't I need a permit?

A permit is not needed for items such as wallpapering, painting, or similar finish work. Plumbing, mechanical, and electric work replacing or repairing fixtures (such as changing water faucets) do not normally require a permit. A permit is also not required for certain agriculture structures. To find out

whether or not your project requires a permit please contact Alton Hillesland at (406) 433-2809 or the State of Montana Building Division at (406) 841-2056.

What if I don't get a permit?

If a permit, when needed, is not obtained before construction, you will have violated County codes and regulations. You then can be subject to fines and penalties. You'll then be required to obtain permits for the work and it must pass inspection or you will have to return the structure or site to its previous condition. Remember construction codes were created for safety reasons. Work built without a permit can be unsafe, no matter how good it looks.

Where do I get a permit?

Building permits are issued by Building Inspector, Alton Hillesland, at 115 2nd Street SE. The Building Office is open from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Or you can find the permit application online at www.richland.org. This application will still need to be taken to the Building Inspector for approval. For electrical, plumbing, and mechanical permits please contact the State of Montana at buildingscodes.mt.gov or call (406)

What about inspections?

It is your responsibility to call for inspections at specific times during construction. You may have your contractor make the call, but it is still your responsibility, as the property owner, to make sure inspections are made. Inspections are made during certain points in the project, depending on the work that's being performed. For example inspections on a new home would include: footings and foundation walls (prior to pouring concrete), Rough framing, electrical, plumbing, and mechanical (prior to installing insulation or drywall), and final inspection.

Remember the project is not complete for legal purposes until it has passed the final inspection.

What if I have a permit but never called for inspections?

Generally, permits expire after 180 days if no inspections have been made. In order for the project to be complete it must pass final inspection. If a permit expires before final inspection, the project is in violation of County codes. If this is the case please contact Building Inspector, Alton Hillesland, at (406) 433-2809 and he will help you reactivate the permit or apply for another.

Enhanced Oil Recovery Being Applied To Tight Oil Reservoirs In The Bakken

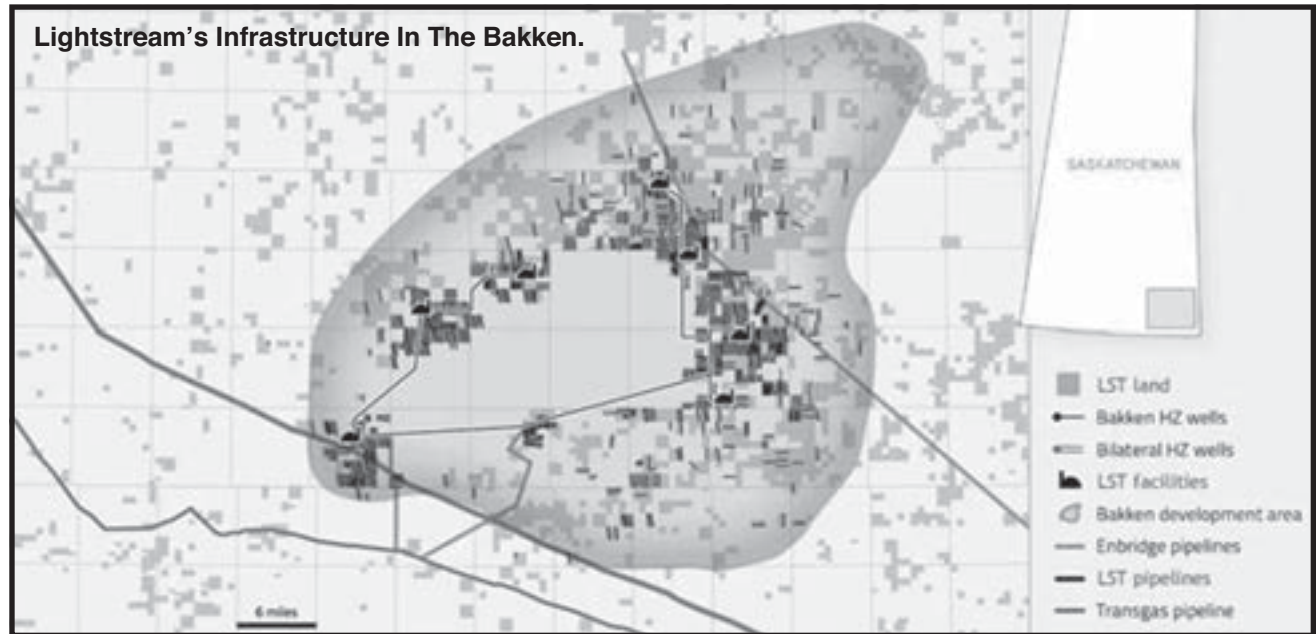



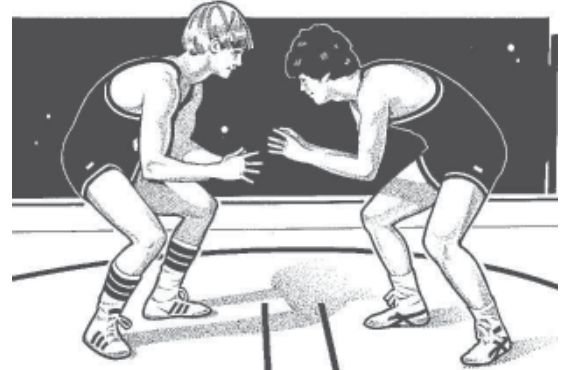

A 2004 study by Montana D.E.Q. found that recycling generated nearly ninety million dollars in revenue, paid over nine million dollars in wages and benefits, and sustained over 300 full-time jobs. At that time, recycling and composting diverted 176,571 tons of material from landfills or 15 percent of Montana's waste stream. In line with national trends, that number has continued to grow!

Community commitment to recycling continues to grow across the state. Rural and urban areas alike are recognizing the public savings of diverting items from the waste stream back into the economy. One success story is Headwaters Cooperative Recycling. Headwaters paved the way for recycling in communities throughout southeastern Montana in Augusta, Beaverhead County, Choteau and more than a dozen other communities. All of these entities are now able to sustain their programs on their own through incorporation of recycling into their public works departments, private partnerships, or community efforts.

The 2004 study noted that "recycling in Montana is more than just a fad, it is a real industry." This America Recycles Day, we see that Recycling is more than just a good idea; it is something we all do in support of our community and our economy.
