Since then the team has developed a work plan each year that aligns with not only the State of Montana but supports the needs and concerns of Richland County indicated by the community in the yearly conferences. Their main focus is increasing seat belt and car seat usage among not only drivers but passengers, to decrease the severity of injuries and deaths in a crash. The team also focuses on reducing distracted driving to decrease the actual number of vehicle crashes in our community. However the team is well aware that there are other safety concerns and as they arise the team and/or task force evaluates how they can bring awareness to the community and help to educate on the needs.

The task force's main focus is reducing DUIs in the community and launched the RADD Campaign (Report a Drunk Driver) asking the community to help keep their community safe. The DUI Task Force Coordinator is a certified RASS trainer which brings education and awareness to those in our communities who sell and serve alcohol. The main focal point for the task force is 21+ so they also bring awareness and education on "Safe Healthy" limits when consuming alcohol. Collaborating with STAND, which focuses on "Under-age Drinking" the task force helps bring awareness and support to those efforts as well.

The team and task force have developed educational programs that can be shared at employee safety meetings or other community group meetings. They also work with employers and others in developing policies to create a healthy and safe environment. The Toshiba Aquillion Prime 160 multi-detector CT system is designed to lower radiation, make exams more comfortable and safer for patients while providing the information required for diagnosis.

"We were able to upgrade from a 64-slice machine to the 160-slice machine at a better rate on our lease agreement. 



Crop Insurance Deadline Approaching for Producers

The USDA's Risk Management Agency (RMA) reminds producers in Montana, North Dakota, South Dakota, and Wyoming that the spring sales closing date is March 15. The spring sales closing and cancellation date applies to spring planted crops, and is also the deadline for producers to notify their agent if they have planted winter wheat in a county with only spring wheat coverage.

There are also important changes for organic producers this year. The five percent surcharge for all acreage insured under organic farming practices has been removed and a new contract price option will be available to organic producers who grow eligible crops under guaranteed contracts. An organic price election is now available for oats, bringing the total number of crops with organic price elections to sixteen. Changes to organic transitional yields (t-yields) will be phased in so they will be more reflective of actual organic farming experience. More information on risk management tools available for organic farmers can be found on the RMA Organic Crops website at: www.rma.usda.gov/news/currentissues/organics/.

This new curriculum, titled Children in Between, is a co-parenting program for divorcing and separating parents. It gives both parents effective strategies to remain calm, make wise decisions, and help children with their adjustment during the parent's separation or divorce. Children often are often placed in difficult situations between their parents, such as carrying messages from one parent to the other, hearing put-downs from one parent about the other, money problems, questions from one parent about the other, and long-distance parenting.

This interactive program is specifically developed to help separating and divorcing parents, in an online format. This allows for parents to take the class in the comfort of their own home, and allows the flexibility to complete the program in several steps to allow for plenty of time for each topic. This online course provides five streaming videos depicting com-

mon problems in divorce, with two solutions to each problem with tutorials and critiques after each solution. During each of these critiques, there are in-depth explanations of key communication skills such as "I" Messages, problem-solving, active listening, reframing, self-talk, and empathy. These topics come in quiz format, which helps reinforce the skills learned, as well as an online discussion forum to answer any questions that arise during the program. In addition to the online quiz, the program comes with divorce education booklets that can be downloaded, as well as references and links, including an option for ongoing e-mail prompts for skill practice. At the suc-



cessful conclusion of the program, a certificate of completion is available to print.

This program was developed by Don Gordon, PhD., a child and family clinical psychologist for over 35 years. Additionally, this program is the only program that focuses on divorce that is listed on the National Registry of Evidence-Based Programs and Practices. While this program is normally \$39.95, the Family Resource Center is happy to offer this program for free, thanks to a grant from the Foundation for Community Care. There are currently eight openings for participants, so call today to reserve your space!

Richland County Conservation District, **Cost Share Applications and Tree Sales**

Submitted by Julie Goss

Applications for the Richland County Conservation District Cost Share program will be accepted through March 7, 2014. The cost share program provides financial assistance for natural resource improvements within Richland County. The program is available to any private sector landowner on property in Richland County. Projects must be on the ground and follow the Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) designs standards and specifications where applicable. Cost share assistance is 50% of the cost recommended on the NRCS cost list and is limited to \$5000.00 per year and a cap of \$10,000 within a 5 year period. Applications will be

ranked and successful applicants will be notified by March 31, 2014. All projects must be completed by December 31, 2014. If you have received cost share from another public entity in the last 5 years you are not eligible for this program. Practices implemented in the past include stockwater wells and pipelines, fences, grass seeding, buried irrigation lines and shelterbelts. Over \$400,000 in conservation practices have been implemented in Richland County since the start of this program in 2011. Deadline for this cost share program is March 7, 2014.

Tree orders will be taken for conservation tree plantings until April 1, 2014. Trees will be delivered in late April or early May. Trees available through the Conservation District are suitable for wind breaks and shelterbelts. Trees can be ordered in bundles of 10 or 25 depending on size and availability. If you need advice on tree selection, pruning techniques, general tree care and maintenance plan to attend our Tree Care and Shelterbelt workshop on Wednesday. March 5, 2014 from 2-5 pm and Thursday, March 6th for a tour of shelter belts in the area. Featured speaker for the workshop is Peter Kolb, MSU Extension Forestry Specialist. The Conservation District is cooperating with MSU Extension-Richland County and the local Natural Resource Conservation Service office to present this workshop.
