"We will be performing parody music and talk about how we pretty much started promoting farming," leader of the group Greg Peterson said.

He said the group has performed in more than 40 states. Their parody videos have attracted more than 100 million viewers on Facebook and YouTube.

"I do all the writing and production of the videos," Greg said. "Ideas come when I'm just working on the farm and thinking creatively."

The Peterson Farm Brothers' first video was "I'm Farming and I Grow it." Their recent hits have included "Pasture Road (Old Town Road Parody)," and "Crazy Grain (Crazy Train Parody)."

Their performances have resulted a solid following. "We've been recognized for a couple of things," Greg said. "We're just trying to promote agriculture whether it's through our videos or posts or in person."

They have done blogs on topics such as GMOS, pesticides, hormones, antibiotics, animal welfare and organic food.

The Petersons work a fifth-generation farm in Assaria, Kan., where they raise beef cattle and have wheat, corn and alfalfa crops.

"We look forward to coming to Montana and meeting some new people," Greg said. "We will provide entertainment as well as education and inspiration."

Livestock reports are due March 1. Owners can report online at [ReportYourLivestock.mt.gov](http://ReportYourLivestock.mt.gov).

Livestock owners must report what they owned as of Feb. 1.

If you reported last year, but no longer own livestock, you still need to submit a reporting form to let us know your livestock count is zero.

Owners preferring a paper reporting form can request one at 406-444-6900 or at any Montana Department of Revenue field office.

Per capita payments are due May 31.

## Montana Dept. Of Revenue: Business Owners Must Report Equipment By March 1

Helena, MT — It's time for businesses to report the equipment they own to the Montana Department of Revenue. Owners can report online using the department's Transaction Portal (TAP) at <https://tap.dor.mt.gov>.

The reporting deadline is March 1 to avoid a 20% penalty.

All businesses must report the equipment they owned as of Jan. 1, if the market value of their business equipment is more than \$100,000 statewide. Owners must file the report even if there were no changes to their business equipment or if they closed or sold their business.

Those businesses whose statewide market value of equipment is \$100,000 or less are exempt from taxation

and do not have a reporting requirement.

ed for 2019 is prepopulated to a business owner's 2020 report. Businesses can use the sort and filter functions to quickly locate assets that need to be updated or deleted. After the report is submitted, the department will send an immediate confirmation receipt.

The contested Republican primary election will be held on June 2.

## Pursuit Injury Crash In McKenzie County

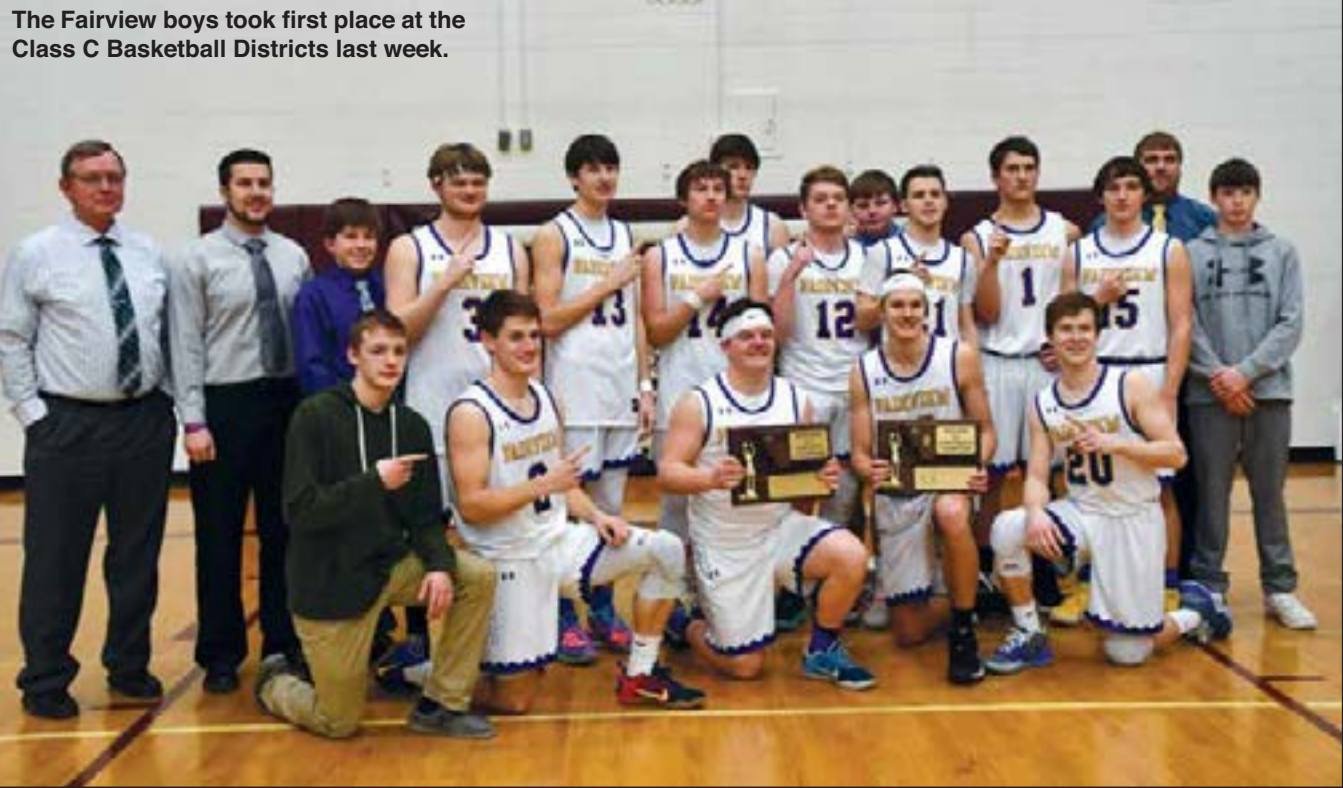

## License Year Begins March 1, Other Changes For 2020

As the current license year is winding down, hunters and anglers can look for a few immediate changes for the coming year.

The new license year starts on March 1, which means that is the day you can buy your 2020 hunting and fishing licenses and begin applying for permits and special licenses.

The deadline to apply for deer and elk permits is April 1.

Hunters should keep a couple of things in mind as they look to the application process for this year.

First, this will be the first year that hunters will be able to apply for all their permits and special licenses at the same time. In the past, those application periods were separate

due to the massive amount of work Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks had to do to enter paper applications. This year, all applications will be done online or electronically at an FWP office.

Another change hunters need to be aware of is the switch to regular paper for licenses, permits and carcass tags. In the past, hunters who applied online waited for their carcass tags to come in the mail. Now they'll be able to print them off at home.

The process is pretty simple: If you're purchasing a general elk or deer license or perhaps a sportsman license, you can do it online; at the conclusion of your purchase you'll have one opportunity to print your carcass tags.

If you're applying for a special license or permit, you will need to have a valid email address. If you're successful in the drawing, you will receive an email with a link to follow to print your carcass tag one time.

The switch from the old license paper to regular paper will be more convenient for customers, who can complete their license application and purchase immediately in the comfort of their own home. The change to online or digital applications will allow for more accurate and quicker drawings. This year hunters who apply for elk and deer permits will know if they were successful two weeks after the deadline.

# USDA Farm Service Agency Livestock Program Reminder

**Submitted by Tammy Lysend**  
Montana livestock producers are reminded to keep updated livestock inventory records. These records are necessary in the event of a natural disaster.

The Livestock Indemnity Program (LIP), administered by USDA Farm Service Agency, provides assistance to eligible producers for livestock deaths in excess of normal mortality caused by adverse weather, disease and attacks by animals reintroduced into the wild by the federal government or protected by federal law. LIP compensates livestock owners and contract growers for livestock death losses in excess of normal mortality due to adverse weather, including losses due to hurricanes, floods, blizzards, wildfires, extreme heat or extreme cold.

For disease losses, FSA county committees can accept veterinarian certifications that livestock deaths were directly related to adverse weather and unpreventable through good animal husbandry and management.

In addition, LIP provides assistance for injured livestock that are sold within 30 days of an eligible loss condition at a reduced price due to adverse weather or attacks by animals reintroduced into the wild by the federal government or protected by federal law.

For livestock death losses, eligible livestock owners must file a notice within 30 calendar days of when the loss is first apparent. Producers should document the adverse weather conditions and date(s) of weather events.

Participants must provide all supporting documentation to their local FSA office no later than 60 calendar days after the end of the calendar year in which the eligible loss condition occurred. Livestock owners and contract growers must record all pertinent information, including the number and kind of all livestock adversely impacted. Some examples of required supporting documentation include:

- Beginning Inventory Records
- Proof of death loss documentation
- Purchase and sales records
- Calving records (include date of birth, date of death and cause of death)
- Preg test records (completed by 3rd party)
- Copy of growers contracts
- Proof of normal mortality documentation

2019 Livestock Losses: In addition to filing a timely notice of loss, producers must submit an application for payment and all supporting documentation by March 2, 2020.

2020 Livestock Losses: In addition to filing a timely notice of loss, producers must submit an application for payment and all supporting documentation by March 2, 2021.

# Preconstruction Work Starting On Scenic Loop At Theodore Roosevelt National Park

**Senator Secured Funding, Interior Secretary's Support To Repair Roadway Damaged By Erosion**

WASHINGTON – Senator John Hoeven announced that preconstruction work on the scenic loop at Theodore Roosevelt National Park will begin this month. On or around Feb. 20, an engineering firm contracted through the Department of Transportation will arrive at the Park to begin undergoing a geotechnical assessment. This work will comprise taking samples of clay to measure moisture levels, groundwater monitoring, mapping the land surface, and installing monitoring equipment to measure any movement under the roadway. The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) determined that a comprehensive geotechnical assessment was necessary to ensure project safety and scope of repairs needed. The senator is pushing to get the assessment started and completed in a timely manner so that construction can start in mid-to late summer with the goal of providing access to the scenic loop by the end of the year.

Hoeven has been working to advance reconstruction of the road, a 28-mile loop that has been rendered unpassable due to erosion. The senator secured federal funding for the repairs, and hosted Interior Secretary David Bernhardt at the TRNP in October to secure his support for maintenance repairs at the park as well as the establishment of Theodore Roosevelt Library.

"Theodore Roosevelt National Park is an important contributor to our state's economy, which is why we've worked to secure funding and support from the Interior Department to prioritize repairs to the scenic drive in the south unit," said Hoeven. "This month, a geotechnical team will begin pre-construction work to ensure the ground is stable, which is an important step in rebuilding this road. We'll continue working to ensure that the Interior Department begins construction as soon as possible."

As a member of the Senate Energy and Natural Resources Committee, Hoeven has also worked to secure committee approval of the Restore Our Parks Act, bipartisan legislation he helped introduce to address deferred maintenance at National Park Service (NPS) facilities. The bill would use 50% of the excess revenues from energy development on federal lands to create a NPS Legacy Restoration Fund to resolve the maintenance backlog, which includes more than \$50 million of maintenance in North Dakota, mostly consisting of road repairs.

# Williams County Injury Crash

On Thursday, Feb. 13, at 7:45 a.m. on Hwy 2, milepost 9, about 7 miles from Williston there was an angle (T-bone) vehicle crash between a 2014 Hyundai Santa Fe SUV with driver Hallie Finnicum, 24, Culbertson and a 2001 Dodge Ram pickup driven by Aaron Tkachyk, 29, Whitefish. This crash occurred on an asphalt roadway with patches of ice and clear weather conditions.

The Dodge was traveling westbound on Hwy 2. The Hyundai was traveling eastbound on Hwy 2. The Dodge lost control, rotated counter-clockwise and entered the eastbound lane of Hwy 2 in front of the Hyundai. The Hyundai struck the Dodge on the passenger side. Finnicum sustained serious injuries and was transported by ambulance to CHI St. Alexius Hospital, Williston, then flown by air ambulance to Trinity Hospital, Minot.

Charges are pending for Aaron Tkachyk. The agencies involved were ND Highway Patrol, Williams County Sheriff's Office, Williston Fire and Ambulance and Williston Rural Fire.

I acquired useful information, such as the use of proper ascetic techniques, disease identification, and ratings. I also established good communication with farmers, consultants, and agriculturalists when they came in to drop off samples."

He has not only worked for the University, but he has also worked for J.R. Simplot Company, which is one of the largest privately-held food and agribusiness companies in the nation. Here he applied and developed new skills as a crop advisor intern. "This past summer, I was a crop advisor intern, and through this internship, I got to travel a little bit. This opportunity to travel really opened my eyes and kind of made me want to see more things and do some

different things. This is what kind of influenced me to take the job position in Montana," said Cymbaluk.

With Cymbaluk's position as Sidney Sugar's agriculturist, he will be putting his skills to work by providing agronomic expertise to area growers in the production of a high-quality beet crop that will increase recoverable sugar per acre. He will be responsible for managing harvest operations and beet storage for assigned areas along with managing grower relationships to attract and retain sugar beet growers.

When asked if he had any goals for the year, he responded that he hopes to get acquainted with all of the sugar beet growers in his area, and he is excited to meet new people. Cymbaluk added, "I hope the background that I have will be helpful, and I hope to motivate and help growers produce a good crop."
